KHASI TRIBE

- Origin: They are an Indigenous Ethnic Group of Meghalaya in north-eastern India, with a significant population in the bordering state of Assam, and in certain parts of Bangladesh.
- Culture: The Main Difference of Khasis with other tribes is that the descendants are recognized from Mother and not from Father.



According to Khasi law and tradition the Mother Inherits the Children and Property but not the father.

- **Festivals:** The major festival celebrated by Khasis is **Nongkrem**. It is a five-day religious festival which falls in the month of November every year.

BLUE FLAG CERTIFICATION

Blue Flag Standards:

- The Blue Flag Beach Standards were established by
 Copenhagen based Foundation for
 Environmental Education (FEE) in 1985 in France
- The Blue Flag is an Environmental award for Beaches, Sustainable boating tourism Operators and Marinas.



Only Local Authorities or Private Beach Operators can apply for a Blue Flag for Beaches

- 4 The Criteria for Blue Flag beaches cover four Main Area:
 - → Water Quality
 - ✤ Environmental Management
 - ▶ Environmental Education and
 - ✤ Safety

In India:

- The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change had started a pilot project under a Unified Coastal Areas Management Programme to develop the Indian beaches according to the Blue Flag standards in December 2017.
- **Chandrabhaga Beach** of Odisha's Konark coast was the first to complete the tag certification process and will be the **First in Asia** to get the Blue Flag certification.

HUMPBACK WHALES

Context: Scientists identified 33 known **Tumour Suppressing Genes in humpback whales** that showed evidence of advantageous changes.

About Humpback Whales:

- It is a species of **baleen** whale. One of the larger rorqual species, adult's range in length from 12–16 m
- The humpback has a distinctive body shape, with long pectoral fins and a knobbly head. It is known for breaching and other distinctive surface behaviors
- They feed in polar waters, and migrate to tropical or subtropical waters to breed and give birth, fasting and living off their fat reserves.
- 4 Their diet consists mostly of krill and small fish
- Once hunted to the brink of extinction, its population fell by an estimated 90% before a 1966 moratorium
- In August 2008, the IUCN changed humpback's status from Vulnerable to Least Concern.

JAPANESE ENCEPHALITIS

- **4** It is an infection of the brain caused by the **Japanese Encephalitis Virus** (JEV).
- While most infections result in little or no symptoms, occasional inflammation of the brain occurs.
- 🔱 In these cases, symptoms may include headache, vomiting, fever, confusion, and seizures

- JEV is generally **spread** by **Mosquitoes**, specifically those of the **Culex** type.
- Pigs and wild birds serve as a reservoir for the virus.

About Japanese encephalitis virus (JEV):

- It is a flavivirus related to dengue, yellow fever and West Nile viruses, and is spread by mosquitoes.
- **Treatment:** There is no Antiviral Treatment for Patients with JE. Treatment is supportive to relieve symptoms and stabilize the patient.
- Prevention and Control: Safe and effective vaccines are available to prevent JE. WHO recommends that JE vaccination be integrated into national immunization schedules in all areas where JE disease is recognized as a Public Health Issue.

Dastak Campaign: UP government is planning to launch a campaign named 'Dastak' to create awareness and beat encephalitis in the state.

This campaign is part of a comprehensive Social and Behavior Change Communication (SBCC) strategy embraced by state government.

Context: It is running successfully to motivate children to learn **Science**, **Maths** and **Technology** through observation and Experimentation


About Rashtriya Avishkar Abhiyan:
