Structure of Answer:

Introduction:

Body:

- Discuss the ill-effects of the climate change that is visible across the country. For example, air pollution, erratic rainfall, etc.
- Explain the current intervention taken by the government is insufficient to address the climate change.
- Explain how air pollution can be making a top priority by way of the people's movement.
- Highlight the government actions regarding the climate change.

• Conclude with the seriousness of the issues and necessary to address the same to reduce the seriousness and India's commitment towards the Global Paris Agreement.
